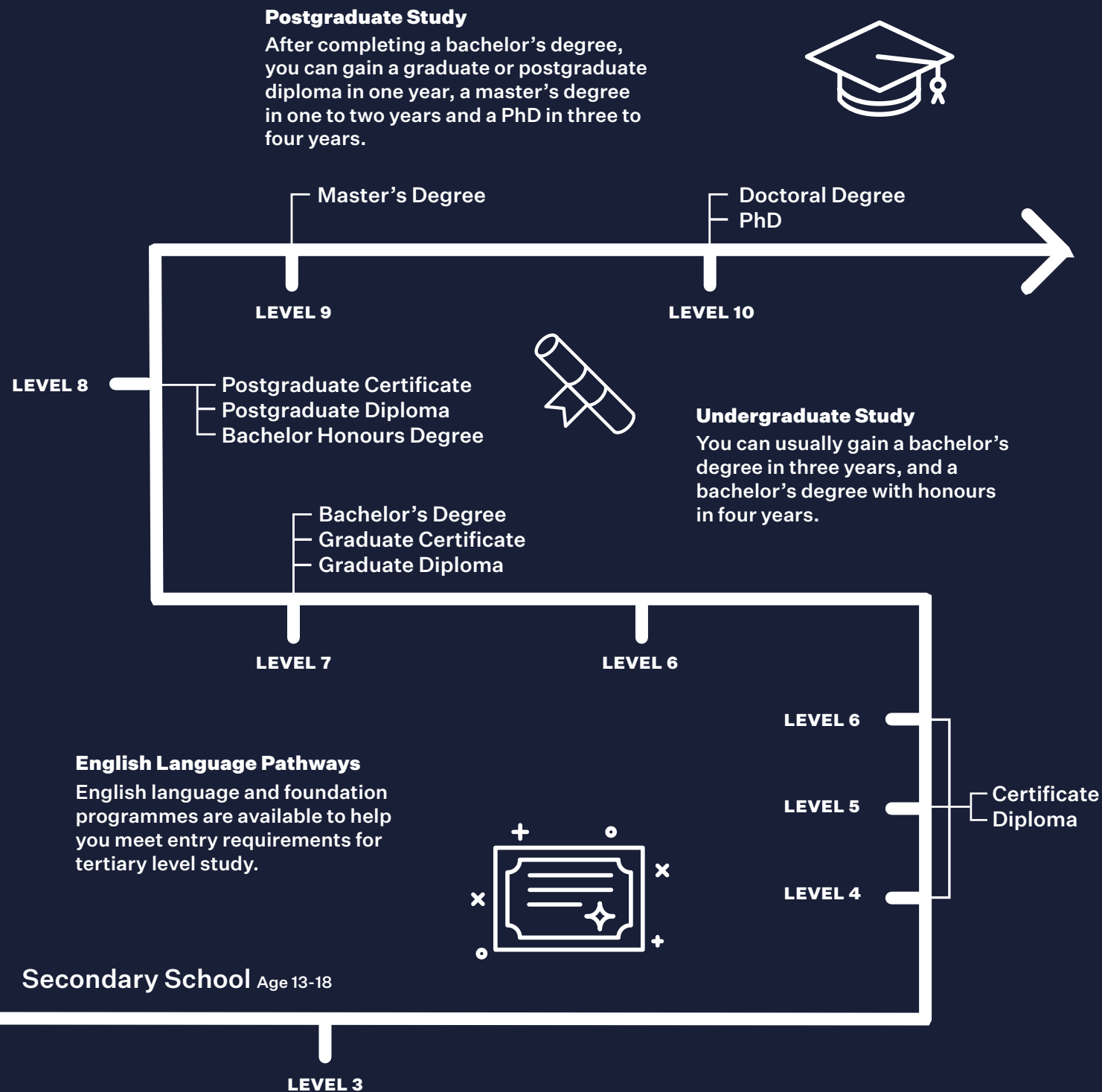

WORK READY

In New Zealand, learning doesn't just take place in the classroom. Your studies may include internships, work placements and industry projects, to give you the opportunity to apply your knowledge in the workplace.

After you graduate, you may be able to stay and work in New Zealand for up to three years on a post-study work visa.
